

Belt with Gilt (gold plated) belt buckle

Hugh de Calais

- Based on an extant piece excavated in London [Documented in *Museum of London Dress Accessories*]
- Hand sewn buckle fixture using linen thread, waxed with a period hard wax of bees wax, pine resin and tallow
- Holes awled using a copy of an awl (depicted in a manuscript illumination)
- Length determined by the 1340's Girdlers Guild regulations
