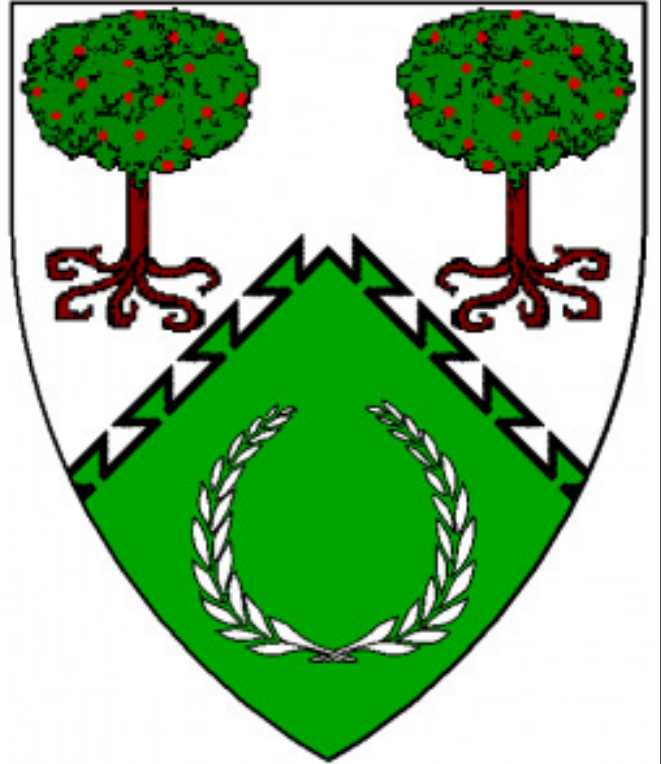
It's been great to see Dence Park working so well and the current 6 month focus on a particular period, Viking, is a great idea. Thank you to all those who have put in the hard work on this.

## From the Rowany Festival 2016 Steward

Hi everyone,

With Festival 2016 bookings due to open shortly, we have some information about the dates and rough outline of Festival.

We've spent some time working out the best way to accommodate the differing needs and preferences of Festival attendees. Thank you to everyone who completed the survey - we ended up with 261 responses.

These responses, along with the ongoing discussions in various groups and email lists, and direct correspondence with the Stewarding Team, have all contributed to the decisions we have made. As always, not everyone will get what they would prefer, but the changes we have made for 2016 address a number of commonly-raised issues.

Most notably, Festival will be starting and finishing earlier. This means that Fighter Auction will fall on the Monday public holiday. In deference to the needs of those traveling long distances, opening court will be combined with the presentation/parade for the Heraldic Melee, on the Thursday morning, rather than the night before as in previous years.

Wednesday will be available as a day for testing new activities, and Tuesday may likewise be available, depending on the schedule for the set-up and delivery of hired equipment.

Other time-tabling remains in flux for now, and will be arranged more firmly as we get close to Festival.

The rules for day-tripping/partial event booking have also changed. Bookings will need to be for specific days, and those with day-trip/partial event bookings will receive coloured lanyards (or similar - we are working on the most non-intrusive option) indicating which day(s) they have booked for. There will be no longer be an overnight price; if you book for two consecutive days, you are

entitled to stay on-site overnight between them. If you book for a single day, or for non-consecutive days, you are not permitted to stay over night.

All attendees will be required to wear their tokens and lanyards at all times, as in previous years, but we will be making additional effort with regard to enforcement.

These changes are due to two main factors. The first is emergency response; we need to know who is and is not on site, as best we can, in the event of an emergency or incident. The second is a change in our contract with Wombaroo, which directly links our attendance to the hiring cost. We are responsible for rendering accurate bookings and attendance data, so we need to ensure that all those on-site have booked appropriately.

We will be introducing a camping area for late-arrivers and early-leavers. This area will be adjacent to the car park, and will cater to those who need greater vehicle access after the event had opened and before it has closed, without interrupting the period feel of the event for other attendees.

There have also been some changes to the site rules, which will be included in both the booking process and confirmations. Pits for sump water disposal and fires will no longer be permitted; fires will be allowed only in existing on-site fire circle or raised braziers/above-ground pits. Additionally, only specified, marked roads will be available for vehicles. All attendees will have access to maps clearly showing which roads can be used by vehicles, and these roads will be physically marked with white stones.

These rules are designed to prevent damage to the site, and are the decision of Camp Wombaroo, as site owners.
