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From the Baron & Baroness of Rowany

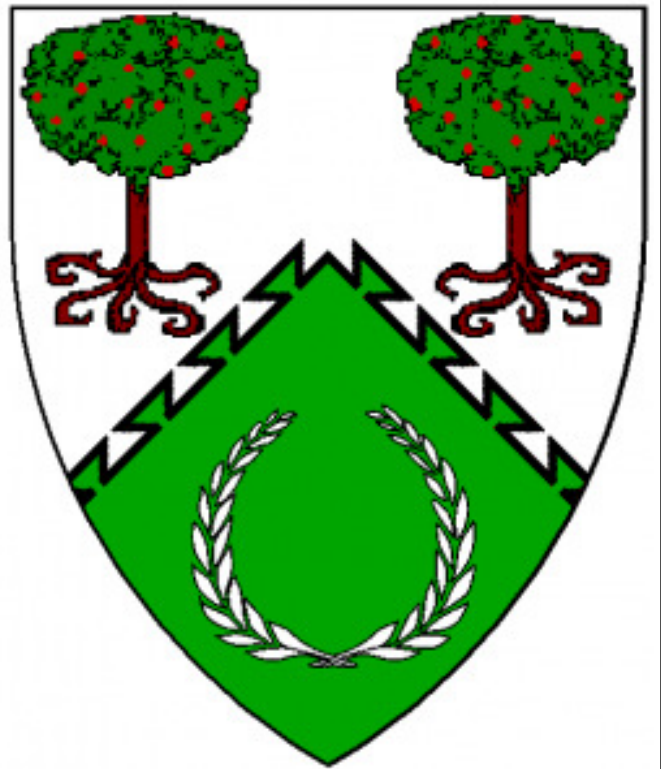
To the Populace of Rowany, do Ameline and Miles send warmest greetings.

Greetings all.

It is now November. Which means that my warrant as Baronial Reeve expires in about a month. To that end, I'm looking for a replacement. The role of Reeve has changed greatly in the time I have held my office - unlike many such roles, it has become simpler! The reeve is a required position in all groups. Duties of the reeve include:

- * day to day financial transactions (reimbursements, payment of invoices, payment to Kingdom of levies and Corporate of GST and non member insurance, some banking)
- * management of financial documentation, such as invoices and receipts on the Baronial Dropbox
- * reporting to the Barony and Kingdom of the financial state of the Barony and attending monthly Senate meetings
- * providing input on event bids, and other matters financial
- * some transaction reconciliations in XERO may be required at times, however they are mostly managed externally.

Please note a few things:

Site rules have changed from 2015. Please note in particular the changes to fire and traffic rules, and the general rules regarding pits (specifically: you can't dig pits, including for waste water disposal and fires). Sites rules can be found in full here: <http://festival.lochac.sca.org/site-information/site-rules/>

Bookings are important.

The numbers from bookings are what we use to order portaloos and allocate camping areas. The earlier you book, the easier it is for the Stewarding Team, and the cheaper the price for you. Also, the more people who book, the more toilets will be ordered.

If you are day-tripping, there are tickets available. They are a LOT cheaper pre-booked rather than paid for at the gate.

Please read the descriptions carefully, and fill out the forms.

If you have children under 5, you still need to book them in, even though they attend for free. This is part of the event reporting requirements. Note that non-member children under 5 must still pay the \$5 insurance amount for event membership.

We prefer payment through the TryBookings site (credit card). If you would like to pay by credit card you will

need to pay a 30c booking fee per item (ticket) and a 2.2% credit card fee that will go directly to the bank. If you prefer to do a Direct Deposit put in the promotion code DirDep when paying.

Then use RF and the last 8 digits of your booking number as your reference.

Equipment bookings are open, via the same bookings process as tickets. Equipment bookings will close on the 28th of February. Please note that all equipment will be available from Wednesday onwards.

If you are staying in the bunks, you will need to make your own arrangements for bedding.

Refunds are available up until bookings close. There will be no refunds after 15th March 2015.

For people with mobility-related disabilities, please ensure you tick the appropriate box.

From Rowany Festival 2016, payment is made with the booking. If you are using Direct Deposit please use RF and then the last 8 digits of your booking number as your reference number.

Once you have been emailed payment information, you have 14 days to finalise payment or your booking will be deemed invalid. If this is the case you will have to submit your booking again, potentially at a higher rate.

To all good gentles, greetings from Jean-Christophe le Saussier, Armoured Champion of Rowany.

It is tradition in these lands that at the great Yuletide gathering, disputes are settled. To that end, a lyst field will be available on the morning of December 5th for those who may wish to settle any dispute where either party has chosen trial by combat.

All bouts are to be fought with matched weapons to 3 good blows. Acceptable weapons are the long sword, sword and buckler and ahlspiess (approximately 3 foot long thrusting spears).

To wit: Challenge matched weapons tournament - counted blows, limbs count as a good blow. There will be a pause to allow combatants to reset. Weapons are long sword, sword and buckler, short spear (no cutting edge). Feel free to bring gauntlets, bucklers and weapons to share around.

Hall Night

Tatianitska will run a poll regarding hall night. Alfar reminded that we will need to inform people about the price difference for the different nights, but will most likely not be moving the night until February next year. Skarpethin has been trying to organise this booking for next year and is awaiting staff to get back to him. Will email consultation when something he gets information.

Purchase of computers

Skarpethin is looking at the possibility of purchasing 2 computers for electronic event sign in, especially at Festival. Currently trying to determine requirements and costings i.e. mobile internet: cost vs coverage, festival specific vs Sydney events. One may also need a webcam for Senate meetings. Both will need full Office Functionality, but needing a webcam leads to one being higher spec than the other. Formal proposal at next months meeting, roughly \$800-\$1000

Festival

Will clarify difference between bunk ticket and full event ticket. There is one month left until 1st price rise. There have been some special requests, and all seem doable. Have been discussing water disposal issue with site owner, and will visit site on Sunday to discuss this, ovens etc. Would like to EOI for 2017 Festival stewards by end of 2015. All agreed.

Proposal for Festival Executive

Please see separate proposal. The Executive positions would be for 4-6 years. Some of this proposal has been inspired by the Pennsic model. It will help with some of the newer issues, such as the larger amount of local government regulations. Thinking along the lines of providing mandatory 2-3 years practice for all Festival Stewards by being Festival Officers, and an Executive will ensure this. Would also like the Liaison position in the executive to not be from Rowany to ensure all people for Lochac are considered. People

who join the Festival Executive will need to understand that it is committing to a term longer than an Officer role. The Festival Steward will bear the brunt of the work, but Executive will ensure continuity between the years. This will be open for comment and will be in the Folia. The positions on the Festival Executive will be chosen the same as Rowany Officers positions i.e. Senate and Seneschal

2015 Yule

Padraig informed us that bookings were coming in, and will be extending bookings open period for a week. It is getting towards breaking even. Ursulans shall be assisting in the kitchen. Tournament will be held 5 December – site to be determined. Talking to Parramatta City Council re roping off area and pavilion. Candles will be allowed in the hall. Requesting \$500 float from Reeve.

Rapier 2nd weekly night: Rapier fighters would try raise money for second practice night within fencers and deposit separately to hall funds.

Rowany Senate Proposal regarding Impact Sensor Project

Method report forthcoming to KEM & Kingdom Chirurgeon. This request should be passed onto Earl Marshall – this decision should not be at a Baronial level. Data will need to be validated to average of reporting from combatants. This information may assist with reporting requests.

Fighter Auction Tourney funds request from Kingdom Historian

Jean-Christophe read from a request for the funds from the Kingdom Historian with respect to 11 day SCA 50th Year Anniversary Celebration to be held in Indiana June 2016. Lochac will exhibit some of its finest A&S works at this event, which has in part been funded by the Stronger Kingdom fund, and we now need to look at how to transport the items. Three options were provided:

1 - \$2500 max for one return economy flight for the Kingdom Historian to travel to the event, carry all the items with them, and man the stall over the celebration period

2 - \$1500 for return postage of 2x20kg boxes. Will not have another person at the other end to set up items, care for them or guarantee their return

3 - \$5000 max for two return economy flights for the Kingdom Historian + 1 to travel to the event, carry all the items with them, and man the stall over the celebration period.

There is approximately \$9000 in the Fighter Auction Tourney funds, and if a motion passed for the Historian to attend, we ask that they document the celebration for Lochac.

Jean-Christophe Motion: Approving up to \$2500 to send one person to Indiana to ensure the display and return of items. Tatianitska seconded. One abstention, remainder in favour. Motion passed.
