### **Expressions of Interest for Festival Steward 2017**

As of this year, Rowany Festival is developing a more structured process for Stewards. Festival has become an event that requires long-term planning and experience with how it is run. In order to ensure that Stewards are adequately prepared for the role, we are asking that anyone interested in taking on the position of Steward in 2017 email both [rowanystewards@gmail.com](mailto:rowanystewards@gmail.com) and [rowanyeneschal@gmail.com](mailto:rowanyeneschal@gmail.com) by January 10th, 2016.

Expressing interest at this time does not oblige you to put in a bid; if you decide that the role is not for you, that's fine. However, if you do not send in an expression of interest, you will not be eligible for consideration as 2017 Steward.

All applicants will be deputy Stewards, and will take on officer and/or deputy roles for Festival 2016. This will ensure that potential 2017 Stewards have hands-on experience of how the event is organised, how it runs and the necessary post-event reporting.

The intention of the Rowany Senate is to develop a three-year cycle for Festival Stewards; as deputy in the first year, as event Steward in the second, and as mentor to the Steward in the third. We also hope to develop a simi-

lar pathway for other officer roles.

### **Rowany Festival Water Disposal**

After extended negotiations with the Wombaroo staff and NSW Water, we have a confirmed system for Festival water disposal.

As we have previously mentioned, we are no longer able to dig sump pits due to the ongoing impact they have on the site.

To help make sure we can dispose of water hygienically, Camp Wombaroo are installing a number of French drains, which will have designated entry points for any wastewater. These will be located to ensure that all campsites have reasonable access. Any water which has been used for cooking, equipment cleaning or similar will need to be strained of any solid matter first, to prevent blockages in the drains.

Showers will be able to drain directly onto the grass, with some caveats. Firstly, all showers need have a plastic pallet, rubber matting or the equivalent to prevent the ground they are on from becoming damaged by the combination of water and foot traffic. There are lots of good options for this at hardware stores and so on. Secondly, shower facilities will have to be set up within designated areas (these will be mapped for all campsites) to ensure that there is sufficient drainage area and that the excess water doesn't flood other campsites.

For groups who use bathtubs, water from those tubs will need to be collected and taken to a drain point in containers, or else piped directly from the tub to the drainage point.

We'll do our best to make these rules as painless as possible, but please understand that we are bound by both site rules and NSW Water regulations (as the area is within a major catchment area).
