- Rowany Yule bids - Two bids have been received. Proposed to defer vote on bids for two weeks so this can be sorted. Will hold an extraordinary Senate meeting on 29 August to decide preferred Yule bid. Finalised bids to be submitted by 26 August for final review. Comments include that the heavy and rapier events should be held on the day before the event so that the Baron & Baroness can announce their champions. Secondly that the \$30/head bid is a little on the lower side and the \$50/head is a little on the higher side.
