Addressee Rowany Fighter Auction Tourney Fund (FATF)

Title: Pennsic Shower Trailer

Action required:

That the Rowany Fighter Auction Fund Committee (FAF), approved the expenditure of \$950.00USD for the purchase and construction of a Shower Trailer for use by members of Lochac attending the Pennsic War.

Deadline:

10 July 2018

Situation:

Members of the Lochac Populace have been attending the Pennsic War at Coopers Lake Camp Ground, Pennsylvania since Pennsic 19. (1990).

When we first attended we were accommodated by House Kilkenny and provided with all the normal camp amenities. As we grew in attendance size and when we became a Kingdom, Lochac was allocated its own Kingdom Permanent Camp Site, XO1.

The number slowly grew as more and more people became aware of Pennsic and more and more members of Lochac started attending. We now have between 30-50 members attending every year with the highest number a few years ago being 98 in camp. These Lochac members camp for two and bit weeks onsite. As anyone that has been to Pennsic will know, most camps larger than 10-15 people have a shower unit they erect for Pennsic.

About 12 years ago we had donated a pop-up tent shower with storage heater and attachments which ran on a gas bottle. That storage heater died 3 years ago and the tent finally died 1 year ago. After consultation with the various Crowns over 3 years we came to a decision to get a mobile shower unit for the use of those attending Pennsic war each year.

We purchased two inline, LPG Gas heaters, but had to wait for a suitable trailer, shower stalls and fittings to be sourced and the shower constructed.

Sir Reese, (David Monahan) volunteered to put the shower trailer together and source all the required equipment for it to be a standalone unit that is to be stored at Pennsic when not in use.

The final price on the shower trailer minus the paint for painting the outside on site, Including the trailer itself, shower stalls, Walls, flooring, plumbing supplies, rivets, sealant etc... it comes to \$950USD. That is \$1252.91 on today's AUD rates. This does not include labour, which is donated to Lochac by Sir Reese.

Given Lochac's regular attendance at this major SCA event, the need for Lochac to have its own portable shower unit is not really a "nice" thing to have, it's a necessity.

Recommendation:

- That the FAF Committee approve the expenditure of \$950.00USD for the cost of the Lochac Shower Trailer.
- That the FAF Committee arrange for \$950US to be given in cash to a member attending Pennsic this year (2018) and pay David Monahan for the materials in making the trailer.
- That the FAF Committee member making the payment obtain a receipt for the amount and that receipt be then delivered to the committee for their records.
- That should the FAF Committee not be able or willing to fund the Shower trailer either for the total amount or for part of the amount they advise the author as soon as possible so that other funding options can be investigated.

Conclusion:

The shower trailer will be used by all persons camping in Lochac Royal at Pennsic. It will be stored at Pennsic during the year. Members using the trailer will be charge an additional \$5.00USD for Pennsic, to cover storage costs for the year.

Fighter Auction Tourney funds request

Names: Amos Ironbeard (Russ Roach), Ulrich of Innigard (Pots Pattulo), Collette de Harcourt (Rebecca Tonkin), Lilavati (Laura Lawrence), Kit Hackforth (Ciaran Sparks)

Location: Barony of Innigard (Adelaide, SA)

What is the bid for? This bid is to seek funds to mitigate travel and event costs for teachers for Fields of Steel, a dedicated Rapier War held in the Barony of Innigard in September 2017. We are seeking:

- 1) Funds for 50% of the travel fee for Master Hanbal al-Barbari, one of our 4 interstate instructors
- 2) Funds for 50% of the event entry cost for our 4 instructors

Who will directly benefit from this bid?

This is the first dedicated rapier war event held in Lochac within at least the last 5 years. The intent of Fields of Steel is to promote rapier war as a form of activity and as such we are bringing in experts in war tactics, strategy and teamwork to offer classes as part of the event. We are also attempting to promote more participation by those who may consider themselves non-combatants, by promoting RBG-only authorizations to allow more people to participate. The Kingdom of Lochac and the Rapier Community are the direct beneficiaries of this bid.

What is the total cost?

We have 4 Guest Instructors for this event we are attempting to bring in and subsidize (in part) their travel and event costs. The total extra costs of this is outlined below:

- Sir Henri de Montferrant from St Florian 50% Travel: \$200
- Sir Henri de Montferrant from St Florian 50% Event: \$50
- Master Caleb Adolphus from Rowany 50% Travel: \$150
- Master Caleb Adolphus from Rowany 50% Event: \$50
- Sir Ysambart Courtin from Politarchopolis 50% Travel: \$150
- Sir Ysambart Courtin from Politarchopolis 50% Event: \$50
- Master Hanbal al-Barbari from Stormhold 50% Travel: \$100
- Master Hanbal al-Barbari from Stormhold 50% Event: \$50

We are seeking to raise the funds for travel for ¼ of our guest instructors via other sources.

Travel costs for Caleb, Ysambart and Hanbal are based off of recent experience driving these distances by Amos (Russ Roach) within the past month. Travel costs for Henri as based off of average return flight Brisbane to Adelaide sitting around \$375-\$400 range. Event costs are based off of advertised event fee.

This is the first time a dedicated Rapier War has been held in Lochac in recent years. The popularity of Rapier War across the Known World shows that it is a viable activity, we just need the experience, the interest and the enthusiasm to make it viable as a regular activity here. To that end we are seeking support from Peers of Lochac, 3/4 of which have a large amount of experience in Heavy War and will be transferring that considerable experience over to the Rapier Community. This is an excellent step in bringing people from the two different forms of combat together, historically there has been clashes in culture between the two groups and we feel this is a great step towards not only providing something new for the Kingdom, but bringing two cultures together and making a stronger Kingdom.

We will also be encouraging all our guest instructors who are driving to load up their cars with people from their home Baronies to add greater value to the money received. Included are paragraphs written by 3 of the 4 potential teachers on their skillset in relation to war and what they bring to the table:

Orlok Hanbal al Barbari
Master of the Pelican, Baron of the Court of Lochac following 4 years as Baron of Stormhold. I first authorised in heavy combat at the end of 1995 and authorised in Rapier soon there-after. I have fought in numerous wars, including the wars at Pennsic during 4 visits to that massive event in the USA (fighting on battlefields containing up to 2000 participants). I have commanded numerous units and have on multiple occasions been given command of one army on the battlefields of Rowany (and at least once at Spring War). Strategy & Battlefield tactics have been one of my deep interests throughout my time with the SCA, learning how to take theories of group combat and bring them to life within the limitations of our combat forms. In the pre-bar world of Rapier I was regularly training local rapier combatants in Stormhold in melee tactics. As I understand it, my teachings at your event are to be along the lines of "Working as a team - small unit tactics & considerations on the SCA battlefield" - bringing learnings from the Heavy war field into the Rapier war field.

Count Henri
"The Five Dimensions of Fighting" It will cover the usual Range, Line, timing etc but specifically show how to adopt them in relation to the different weapon forms but also how they relate in tourneys, melees and wars. It presents a unification of theories across fencing and heavy that can be utilised in any format of fighting. The class will be in armour but will involve some helm off work and then some in helm time to work it through at full speed. Heavies and fencers are both encouraged to attend and can learn side by side as it's the same principles.

Sir Ysambart Courtain Combatant - 23 years. Member of over a dozen war units, commanded half of them. Founded the Saint Florian Militia, 15 combatants. Commanded units of 20+ combatants for Ventbarre, Riverhaven, Attica and Mordenvale Generated 75 combatant sides at Festival. Marshal-in-Charge for large events including Rowany Festival and Fields of Gold. Best trainer of the wrap shot in Lochac. Primary armourer combat trainer and war preparer for Saint Florian for ten years. Order of Chivalry. Initial trainer for 10+ members of the chivalry. Formulated and taught my War Class at Knights school and Poltarchopolis. Advised that the War Class, as applied to the Fencing melee field, had direct application. Upcoming Fencing

Festival In SA Will teach a) the War Class, and b) Lichtenauer 101. Value: Will use the teachers travel fee to bring myself and others from ACT to SA

The War Class is a introduction to war fighting for the Lochacian. It is aimed at the beginner level, including not yet authorised. The class requires a weapon simulant for each combatant. They will not fight full speed, but they will walk at up to a jog-trot. It is the distilled and codified wisdom of 24 years of the Lochac warfield. It is about how to be a useful member of a war unit, how to understand Lochac warfield roles, and how to lead and how to be lead. Lichtenauer 101 is an introduction to the teachings of Johan Lichtenauer as it applies to the longsword. It is aimed at the beginner level, including not yet authorised. The class requires a longsword simulant for each combatant. Full gear is encouraged, but not required. It goes into the history of Judicial combat, swordmasters, fightbooks, and the Society of Lichtenauer. The class practically teaches the concepts of "Feeling" for "Weak" or "Strong". It gives drills basic strikes, and how to respond for when you feel either weak or strong.
